The driver must first go to the Technical Inspection located in the Paddock to have their safety equipment checked. If the equipment is found to be adequate and correct, the driver will receive a slip that can be used to collect their driver's armband.

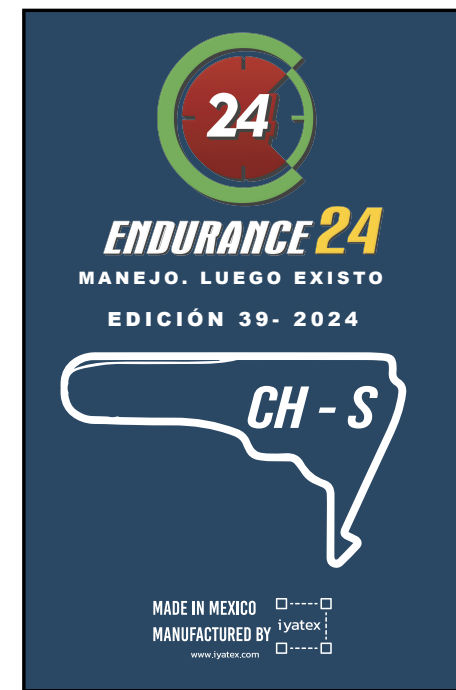

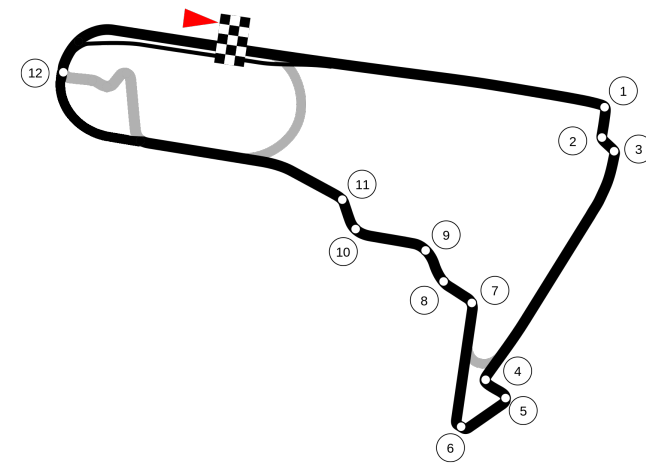

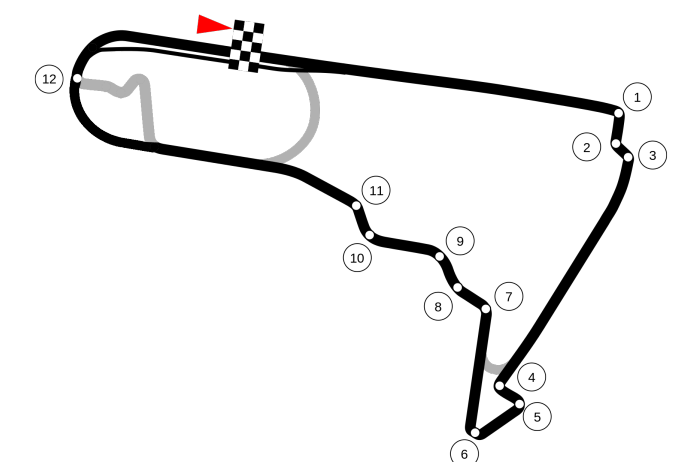

DRIVERS' MEETING

At each meeting, a summary with the key points related to the event will be distributed.

It is the driver's responsibility to be aware of their category's meeting schedule and attend it. The Drivers' Meeting schedule is indicated in the Official Activities Program.

A roll call will be conducted before each meeting starts. Drivers who do not attend will lose their qualifying time and must report to the Event Secretary on the 1st floor of the Control Tower to receive the meeting summary in order to start.

Drivers who do not attend or arrive late will lose their qualifying time and start at the back of the grid; to start, they must report to the Event Secretary at the Pits Tent to receive the meeting summary.

The valid 2023 FEMADAC License (driver's badge) will be checked by the CNP Commissioner during the Drivers' Meeting, and each driver will receive a wristband to confirm they have it. This wristband will be required at the pit exit to allow the car onto the track.

It is the responsibility of each team to correctly place the Timing Chip and to provide complete information: name, number, car make, and team name.

Chip rental should be arranged directly with the official Timing provider.

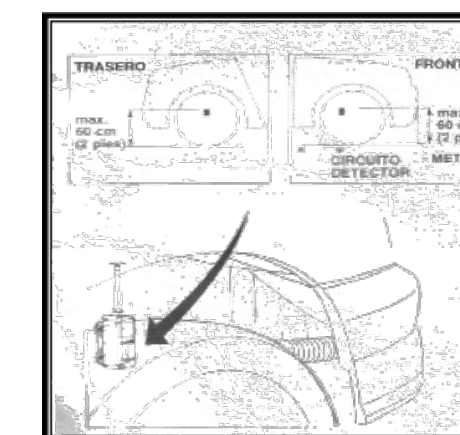

GARAGES

A minimum of 4 cars per garage is allowed. Teams must adhere to the garage assignments provided by the Organizing Committee.

It is strictly prohibited by Civil Protection-AHR regulations to:

- Place and/or hang banners facing the exterior of the garages.
- Consume alcoholic beverages.
- Block the entrance and exit of the garage with objects.
- Set up lounge areas or furniture inside the garage.
- Install any type of tent, canopy, or structure.
- Use the garage as a resting area.

All garages must be equipped with:

- A valid fire extinguisher.
- A bucket of water.
- A broom with a brush.
- A bucket of cement or silica sand.
- A container for disposing of fuel, solvents, and oils.

During the event, Civil Protection-Iztacalco Delegation will conduct a safety inspection. If all the aforementioned requirements are not met, the authorities may close the garage, including all cars inside it.

Garages are work areas for participating cars, so they must be kept in the best possible order to fulfill their primary purpose. If you have any questions, please consult the Organizing Committee in advance.

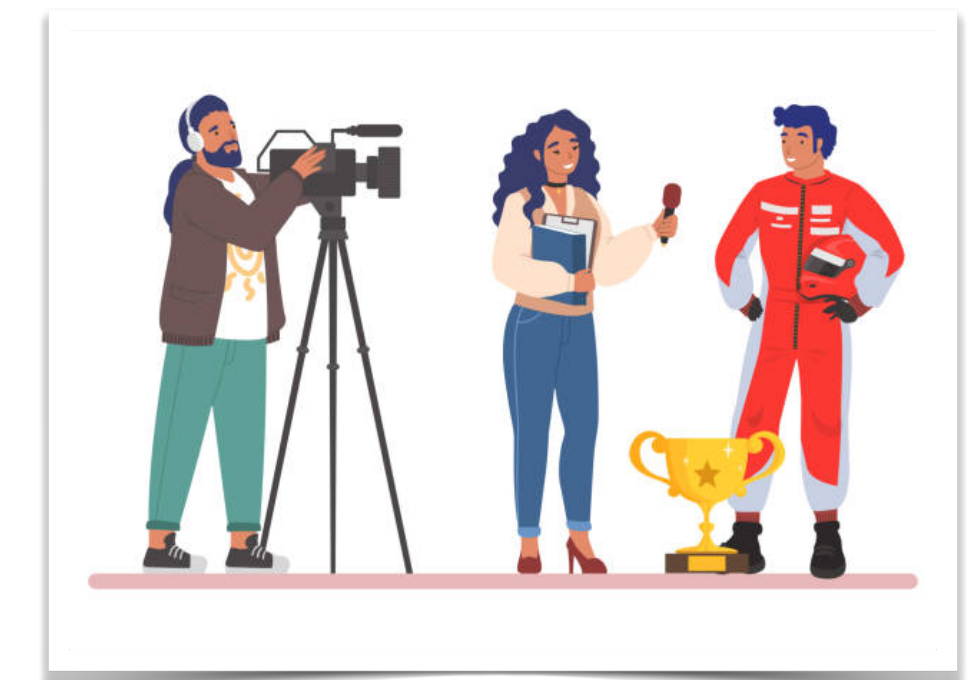
